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Dear Ms. McNeal:

On Friday March 21, 2014, I filed compliance tariffs on behalf of Ohio Power Company (AEP Ohio), in accordance with the Commission's Finding and Order dated March 19, 2014 in Case Nos. 13-1892-EL-FAC *et al* (Finding and Order). Consistent with the Finding and Order, AEP Ohio's compliance tariffs reflected the new Auction Phase-In Rider (APIR) and Fixed Cost Rider (FCR) that were approved to jointly replace the existing Fuel Adjustment Clause (FAC). Though it was already implied from the compliance filing and would become even more evident through the new version of AEP Ohio's tariffs once published, I would like to clarify up front that as part of the compliance filing the Company's FAC tariffs will be cancelled effective April 1, 2014. The costs formerly reflected in the FAC, including the final reconciliation during 2015, will be reflected in the APIR and FCR going forward as of April 1, 2014.
