
Thank you for contacting the Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB) regarding Carroll County Energy, LLC's proposed electric generation facility in Carrollton, Ohio. Your correspondence concerning the project has been docketed in case number 13-1752-EL-BGN.

The enclosed *Staff Report of Investigation*, filed in this case on February 19, 2014, includes a clear map of the project area and nearby residences and evaluates your areas of concerns, including noise, water and wastewater, site selection, and site access. The enclosed joint stipulation, filed on March 10, 2014 by Carroll County Energy, Washington Township, and the Board's staff, recommends that the Board authorize construction of the facility subject to 17 conditions to mitigate potential impacts. I anticipate that the Board will schedule this case for a decision within the next several months.

I understand from your letter that you planned to attend the Board's local public hearing held on March 6, 2014 at Carrollton High School. You may also be interested in reviewing the transcripts for this hearing and the adjudicatory hearing held at the Board's offices in Columbus on March 13, 2014. 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To Whom ever it concern,


I am oppose to the new Power plant for many unanswered questions and location of plant.
