## **ENTRY**

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On January 22, 2014, the Commission issued an entry directing that each reporting company submit its annual report using the Commission's new on-line system by April 30, 2014, or contact the Commission's Docketing Division.
- (2) To date more than 1,000 reports have been successfully filed using the on-line system. However, Staff is concerned that, due to technical issues, some companies may not have been able to file or did not receive appropriate notice of their filing obligations. No report has been submitted, nor has a request for a 30-day automatic extension been filed, for a relatively large number of companies that were issued certificates in 2013. Accordingly, a blanket 30-day extension should be granted to allow Staff additional time to ensure that any technical issues have been resolved, and that all regulated entities have been contacted regarding their filing obligations, and all companies will be granted until May 30, 2014, to submit their reports.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That each reporting company be granted until May 30, 2014, to file its annual report. It is, further,

ORDERED, That notice of this Entry be served via the Electric-Energy, Gas-Pipeline, Railroad, Telephone, and Water industry listserves, and upon each reporting company that holds authority or a certificate for which no annual report has been submitted or a request for an extension has been filed.
