## **ENTRY**

The Commission finds:

- Pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-12, Staff served a notice of preliminary determination upon R&R Trucking, Inc. (Respondent), alleging violations of the Commission's transportation regulations relating to brakes, tires, driver's record of duty status, and maintenance pursuant to 49 C.F.R. 393.47(e), 49 C.F.R. 393.53(b), 49 C.F.R. 393.75(c), 49 C.F.R. 395.8(a), and 49 C.F.R. 396.3(a)(1).
- (2) On February 13, 2014, Respondent, through legal counsel, filed a request for an administrative hearing in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-13. Thereafter, a prehearing conference was scheduled and held on April 1, 2014.
- (3) On April 10, 2014, Staff filed a motion to dismiss the case. In the motion to dismiss, Staff stated that, after a review of the facts and further investigation and discussion with the Ohio Highway Patrol, it determined that further prosecution of the alleged violations is not warranted and the violations should be deleted.
- (4) The Commission finds that Staff's motion to dismiss should be granted and this case should be dismissed.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That Case 14-257-TR-CVF be dismissed and closed of record. It is, further,

ORDERED, That the violations be removed from Respondent's history of violations and Safety-Net record. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon each party of record.
