

#### SNET America, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Long Distance East

SNET America, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Long Distance East, which holds Ohio Certificate No. 90-6360, issued on October 26, 2006, is discontinuing Calling Card service, pending the necessary regulatory approvals. The only service that this entity provides in Ohio is intrastate Calling Card service when its Calling Card customers come to Ohio and make intrastate toll calls using their Calling Cards. In its annual report for 2013, the entity reported \$97.00 in intrastate revenue in Ohio. Based on the discontinuation of its service, the SNET America, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Long Distance East certificate should be cancelled.


