The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) Pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-2, Commission Staff served a notice of preliminary determination upon Roeder Cartage Company, Inc. (Roeder) alleging violations of the Commission's transportation regulations.
- (2) On March 13, 2014, Roeder filed a request for an administrative hearing in the above-captioned case in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-13.
- (3) A prehearing settlement conference was held on April 29, 2014; however, the parties were unable to settle this matter.
- (4) By Entry issued on May 5, 2014, the attorney examiner scheduled this matter for hearing on May 28, 2014.
- (5) On May 27, 2014, Staff filed a motion to continue this case and a memorandum in support. Staff asserts in the motion that the parties have reached a verbal settlement and that a hearing is no longer necessary.
- (6) The attorney examiner finds that the motion is reasonable and should be granted. The parties should file the settlement in this case no later than June 30, 2014. If a settlement is not filed in this case by June 30, the attorney examiner will schedule a hearing by subsequent entry.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That Staff's motion to continue this case is granted, in accordance with Finding (6). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon each party of record.
