Electric Advisors incorporated July 3, 2006 to provide energy brokerage services for procurement of electricity and natural gas contracts to business customers in Maryland and Washington, D.C. Since incorporation the business territory has expanded to include the states of New Jersey, Connecticut, New York, Pennsylvania, Delaware, Texas, Illinois, Rhode Island, and Massachusetts. In 2010 Electric Advisors added a residential program via Washington Gas Energy Services (WGES).

The list of suppliers whom Electric Advisors has agreements with has increased to ten and include Constellation, NextEra Energy, WGES, UGI, Hess, Blue Star Energy, Champion Energy Services, Liberty Power, Direct Energy, and ConEd Solutions.

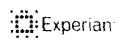

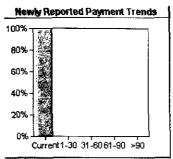

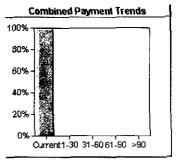
