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ATTORNEY EXAMINER PIRIK: We'll go on the record in the matter of the Application of Duke Energy Ohio for Administration of the Significantly Excessive Earnings Test under R.C. Section 4928.143(F) and Ohio Administrative Code 4901:1-35-10 for 2013.

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1 ATTORNEY EXAMINER PIRIK: Thank you. 2 I'll turn to the Company. I know we have some 3 exhibits and perhaps a stipulation. 4 MS. KINGERY: Yes, your Honor. Thank 5 you. I would ask that the -- that you would mark as Duke Energy Ohio Exhibit 1 the Application that was 6 filed in the docket on April 30, 2014. 7 8 ATTORNEY EXAMINER PIRIK: The document will be so marked. 9 10 MS. What is your business address? 13 Α. 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215. 14 By whom are you employed and in what 15 Q. 16 capacity? 17 The Public Utilities Commission of Ohio, 18 and I'm a Utility Rate -- or a Utility Specialist 3. 19 Okay. Mr. Buckley, you, I assume, have Q. 2.0 heard the marking of several exhibits, the 2.1 Stipulation and Recommendation, Joint Exhibit 1, and 22 also the Company's two exhibits, the testimony of Miss Laub and the Application. I am. Good. Do you believe that it was -- it 14 Q. was negotiated by knowledgeable parties? 15 16 Α. T do. 17 Okay. Does it violate any regulatory Q. policy, principle, or practice? 18 19 Not that I know of. Α. 2.0 Good. Does it advance the public Q. 2.1 interest? 22 I believe it does. Α.
