## **ENTRY**

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On June 28, 2013, as amended on August 12, 2013, Duke Energy Ohio, Inc. (Duke), filed the instant application, requesting approval of its updated system reliability targets, in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-10-10.
- (2) By Entries issued November 15, 2013, and May 28, 2014, the Ohio Consumers' Counsel (OCC) and the Ohio Energy Group, respectively, were granted intervention in this matter.
- (3) By Entry issued April 10, 2014, as revised by Entry issued May 28, 2014, the attorney examiner established the following procedural schedule:
  - (a) The evidentiary hearing shall commence on June 10, 2014, at 10:00 a.m.
  - (b) Duke shall file its testimony by June 30, 2014.
  - (b) Staff and intervenors shall file testimony by July 11, 2014.
  - (c) The evidentiary hearing shall reconvene on July 22, 2014, at 10:00 a.m.
- (4) The evidentiary hearing commenced, as scheduled, on June 10, 2014.
- (5) On June 27, 2014, Duke, Staff, and OCC filed a joint motion to extend the procedural schedule in this matter for 30 days. In support of the motion, they state that the parties are discussing a resolution to the issues presented in this case and they need more time to continue those discussions.

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(6) Upon consideration of the joint motion, the attorney examiner finds that it is reasonable and should be granted. Accordingly, the procedural schedule should be revised, as follows:

- (a) Duke shall file its testimony by July 30, 2014.
- (b) Staff and intervenors shall file testimony by August 13, 2014.
- (c) The evidentiary hearing shall reconvene on August 19, 2014, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, 11th Floor, Hearing Room 11-D, Columbus, Ohio 43215-3793.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That, in accordance with finding (6), the joint motion to continue the procedural schedule is granted and the revised schedule be adopted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
