Unfortunately, due to an inadvertent administrative error, Celina failed to file its renewal application by the filing deadline of July 24, 2014. The Commission will receive a filed copy of Celina's 2014 renewal application by August 24, 2014. There have been no material changes in Celina's business practices as defined in Rule 4901:1:1-24-10 of the Ohio Administrative Code ("OAC").

Celina respectfully requests that the Commission extend Certificate No. 04-087G(5) to September 24, 2014. Celina apologizes for this administrative oversight and pledges that all reports and certifications required by the Commission will be timely filed in the future.
