ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On June 6, 2014, Complainant, Dorinza Johnson, filed a complaint against Respondent, The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company (CEI), alleging that she is entitled to PIPP credits that she has not received.
- (2) On June 28, 2014, CEI filed, pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901-9-01(F), a motion to dismiss this case with prejudice, on grounds that it has been settled.
- (3) Ohio Adm.Code 4901-9-01(F) provides that, if the public utility complained against files an answer or motion which asserts that the complaint has been satisfied and no response is filed within 20 days, the Commission may presume that satisfaction has occurred and dismiss the complaint. No response to CEI's motion to dismiss has been filed. Accordingly, this case should be dismissed.

ORDERED, That this case be dismissed with prejudice and closed of record. It is, further,
