MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT

Marion was issued Certificate No. 02-019G(6) on September 1, 2012 with an

expiration date of September 1, 2014. Previously these filings were being handled by a third

party energy broker who is no longer retained by Marion. When the relationship was

terminated, responsibility for the renewal certification filings was inadvertently overlooked.

Accordingly, Marion failed to file its renewal application for natural gas governmental

aggregation by the filing deadline of August 1, 2014. The PUCO will receive a filed copy of

Marion's renewal application by August 21, 2014, which will not provide the PUCO with the

requisite 30 days to review the renewal application before the expiration date. Marion

requests that its current certification be extended until September 21, 2014.

Marion maintains that this extension will not prejudice any party.

Wherefore, City of Marion respectfully requests that the Commission grant its Motion

for Extension of Certification Expiration Date.
