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4 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Good morning.
5 The Public Utilities Commission of Ohio calls
6 for hearing at this time and place Case No.
7 14-0401-EL-RDR being in the matter of the
8 application of The Dayton Power and Light
9 Company to establish an economic development
10 rider.

11 My name is Bryce McKenney and I am
12 the Attorney Examiner assigned by the Commission
13 to hear this case. At this time I would like to
14 take the appearances of the parties. If I may
15 begin with the company.

16 MS. SOBECKI: Good morning, your
17 Honor. Judi Sobecki on behalf of The Dayton
18 Power and Light Company, 1065 Woodman Drive,
19 Dayton, Ohio 45432.

20 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Thank you. On
21 behalf of Staff.

22 MR. O'ROURKE: Thank you, your
23 Honor. Ryan O'Rourke representing Staff with
24 the Ohio Attorney General's office. My address
25 is 180 East Broad Street, 6th Floor in Columbus,

1 Ohio 43215.

2 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Thank you, Mr.
3 O'Rourke. I recognize that a stipulation and
4 recommendation has been filed in this case. Is
5 there anything to do before we proceed?

6 If there is nothing, Ms, Sobecki,
7 are you ready to call your first witness?

8 MS. SOBECKI: I am, your Honor.
9 As a preliminary matter I would like to mark my
10 exhibits just to make the process go a little
11 smoother, if that is all right.

12 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: We can do that.

13 MS. SOBECKI: The first exhibit is
14 Joint Exhibit No. 1 which is the Stipulation and
15 Recommendation filed on July 8th, 2014.

16 ATTORNEY EXAMINE: It will be so
17 marked.

18 MS. SOBECKI: Company Exhibit No. 1
19 will be the application filed in this case.

20 And Company Exhibit No. 2 will be
21 the testimony of Nathan Parke filed on July 21,
22 2014.

23 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: They will be so
24 marked.

25 MS. SOBECKI: And with that I would

1 like to call Nathan Parke to the stand.

2 (WITNESS SWORN)

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4 NATHAN C. PARKE

5 called as a witness on behalf of the Company,
6 being first duly sworn, testified as follows:

7 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Please state
8 your name and address for the record.

9 THE WITNESS: My name is Nathan C.
10 Parke. Business address is 1065 Woodman Drive,
11 Dayton, Ohio.

12 DIRECT EXAMINATION

13 By Ms. Sobecki:

14 Q. Good morning, Mr. Parke. Mr. Parke,
15 by whom are you employed?

16 A. I am employed by The Dayton Power
17 and Light Company.

18 Q. And what is your position?

19 A. I am the Manager of Regulatory
20 Operations.

21 Q. And, Mr. Parke, you have in front of
22 you some exhibits we have marked. Could you
23 please identify for us Joint Exhibit No. 1?

24 A. That is the application for the
25 Dayton Power and Light Company to update its

1 Economic Development Rider.

2 Q. That would be Company Exhibit No. 1.

3 So Joint Exhibit No. 1 --

4 A. Joint Exhibit No. 1 is the
5 stipulation and recommendation.

6 Q. And Company Exhibit No. 1, could you
7 identify that, please?

8 A. That is the application of the
9 Dayton Power and Light Company to update its
10 Economic Development Rider.

11 Q. And what is Company Exhibit No. 2?

12 A. That is my testimony.

13 Q. Okay.

14 A. In support of the stipulation.

15 Q. Looking at Company Exhibit No. 2, do
16 you have corrections or changes to that
17 testimony?

18 A. I do not.

19 Q. Was that testimony prepared by you
20 or at your direction?

21 A. Yes, it was.

22 Q. And if I were to ask you the same
23 questions as depicted in that testimony here
24 today would your answers be the same?

25 A. Yes, they would.

1 Q. And would those answers be truthful?

2 A. Yes.

3 MS. SOBECKI: I have nothing
4 further, your Honor.

5 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Thank you, Ms.
6 Sobecki. Anything from the Staff?

7 MR. O'ROURKE: Nothing from Staff.

8 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: All right. I
9 have nothing further. Thank you, Mr. Parke.

10 MS. SOBECKI: Your Honor, with that
11 I would move to admit Joint Exhibit No. 1 and
12 Company Exhibits No. 1 and 2.

13 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Any objection?

14 MR. O'ROURKE: No, your Honor.

15 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Joint Exhibit 1
16 will be admitted. Company Exhibits 1 and 2 will
17 also be admitted.

18 (EXHIBITS HEREBY ADMITTED INTO
19 EVIDENCE)

20 MS. SOBECKI: Your Honor, I have
21 nothing further.

22 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Thank you.
23 Anything from Staff?

24 MR. O'ROURKE: Just briefly from
25 Staff, your Honor. We would have one exhibit

1 that we would like to move into the record.
 2 It has been previously marked Staff Exhibit 1.
 3 It is the Staff's review and recommendations on
 4 this case that were submitted on April 22nd,
 5 2014.

6 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: It will be so
 7 marked. Any objection to the admission of Staff
 8 Exhibit 1?

9 MS. SOBECKI: No objection, your
 10 Honor.

11 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: It will be so
 12 admitted.

13 (EXHIBIT ADMITTED INTO EVIDENCE)

14 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Anything
 15 further from Staff?

16 MR. O'ROURKE: Nothing.

17 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Anything further
 18 from the Company?

19 MS. SOBECKI: No, your Honor.

20 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Seeing nothing
 21 further we are adjourned. Let's go off the
 22 record. Thank you.
