APPLICATION OF TARIFF

This tariff, filed by Talk America Services, LLC, hereinafter referred to as "the Company", describes the regulated service terms, conditions, and rates required in conformance with Competitive Retail Telephone Rules (Case No. 10-1010-TP-ORD). Services will be provided in compliance with Minimum Telephone Services Standards. The Company provides certain detariffed services which are not in the Company's tariff on file with the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (Rule 4901:1-06-11(A)(2).

The Company is certified to provide service pursuant to the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio's decision in Docket Number 14- -TP-ACE.

MISCELLANEOUS SERVICES

Special Construction

Basis for Charges

Where the Company furnishes a facility or service for which a rate or charge is not specified in the Company's tariffs, charges will be based on the costs incurred by the Company and may include: (1) nonrecurring type charges; (2) recurring type charges; (3) termination liabilities; or (4) combinations thereof.

Basis for Cost Computation

The costs referred to above may include one or more of the following items to the extent they are applicable:

- A. Cost installed of the facilities to be provided including estimated costs for the Cearrangements of existing facilities. Cost installed includes:
 - 1. Equipment and materials provided or used,

MISCELLANEOUS SERVICES

Emergency Services (Enhanced 911)

This service allows Customers to reach the appropriate emergency services including police, fire and medical services. Enhanced 911 has the ability to selectively route an emergency call to the primary E911 provider so that it reaches the correct emergency service located closest to the caller. In addition, the Customer's address and telephone information will be provided to the primary E911 provider for display at the Public Service Answering Point (PSAP). These services will be provided free of charge to all Customers.

The Company will collect 911 surcharges on a per line basis and remit all surcharge revenue to the appropriate government entity.

Telecommunications Relay Service (TRS)

Telecommunications relay service enables deaf, hard-of-hearing or speech-impaired persons who use a Text Telephone (TT) or similar devices, to communicate freely with the hearing population not using TT and visa versa. A Customer will be able to access the state provider to complete such calls.

Customers may be assessed a charge per line per month to fund Telecommunications Relay Services for the State of Ohio in accordance with Section 4905.84 of the Revised Code. This charge shall in no event exceed the per end-user line (or equivalent) assessment levied by the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio upon the Company.

Presubscription

TAI initially will resell Windstream CLEC/LD Companies' residential service and will rely on their managerial and technical capabilities. Therefore, TAI also will have the managerial and technical capability necessary to provide high quality services. In addition, Communications Sales and Leasing, Inc.
