The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) Staff served a notice of preliminary determination upon Harold Mason, in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-12, alleging a violation of the Commission's transportation regulations.
- (2) On July 30, 2014, Mr. Mason filed a request for an administrative hearing in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-13.

- (4) The parties in this case are directed to participate in a prehearing conference on September 16, 2014, at 10:00 a.m., Eastern Daylight time. At that time, the attorney examiner will attempt to contact Mr. Mason by telephone.

ORDERED, That a prehearing conference in this case be scheduled in accordance with Finding (4). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon each party of record.
