## <u>ENTRY</u>

The Commission finds:

- (1) The above-referenced complaint was filed on April 17, 2014. In the complaint, Brenda Diggs (Ms. Diggs) alleged that The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company (CEI) used unjust billing practices with regard to an electric bill for service at her rental property, 2911 East 123 Street, Cleveland, Ohio.
- (2) On May 8, 2014, CEI filed a motion to dismiss the complaint. In the motion, CEI stated that it resolved the dispute raised by Ms. Diggs in her complaint; therefore, the complaint should be dismissed.
- (3) On May 27, 2014, Ms. Diggs filed a letter stating that the complaint had not been resolved.
- (4) On July 23, 2014, CEI filed a renewed motion to dismiss, again stating that the dispute with Ms. Diggs has been resolved.
- (5) Thereafter, on August 8, 2014, Ms. Diggs and CEI filed a joint motion to dismiss the complaint. In the motion, both parties state that they have resolved their dispute. The parties, therefore, request that the complaint be dismissed with prejudice.
- (6) In view of the resolution of the complaint, this case should be dismissed.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the parties' joint motion to dismiss be granted and that this case be dismissed with prejudice. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon each party of record.
