ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On March 26, 2012, Hess Corporation (Hess) filed an application for renewal of its certification as a competitive retail natural gas supplier. On March 28, 2012, Hess filed a motion for a protective order, pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901-1-24(D), requesting that two documents be kept under seal, namely, Exhibit C-5 of Hess' March 26, 2012 certification renewal application, filed on March 27, 2012, as well as the unredacted version of the supplemental response to that same exhibit, filed under seal by Hess on April 25, 2012.
- (2) By Entry dated May 24, 2012, Hess' motion for a protective order was granted.
- (3) The Entry granting Hess' motion for a protective order noted that Ohio Adm.Code 4901-1-24(F) requires a party wishing to extend a protective order to file an appropriate motion at least 45 days in advance of the protective order's expiration date. Hess was advised that, if it wished to extend the confidential treatment of the exhibit and supplemental response that were the subject of the May 24, 2012 protective order, it should file an appropriate motion at least 45 days in advance of the expiration date. Further, if no such motion to extend confidential treatment was filed, the Commission might, without prior notice to Hess, release the information covered under the May 24, 2012 protective order.
- (4) No motion to extend the protective order issued May 24, 2012, has been filed.
- (5) Accordingly, on September 15, 2014, the docketing division is directed to release to the public record, two documents, namely, Exhibit C-5 of Hess' March 26, 2012 certification renewal

application, filed on March 27, 2012, as well as the unredacted version of the supplemental response to that same exhibit, filed under seal by Hess on April 25, 2012.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the Commission's docketing division release to the public record, on September 15, 2014, the exhibit and supplemental response that were the subject of the May 24, 2012 protective order, namely, Exhibit C-5 of Hess' March 26, 2012 certification renewal application, filed on March 27, 2012, as well as the unredacted version of the supplemental response to that same exhibit, filed under seal by Hess on April 25, 2012. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon each party of record.
