## <u>ENTRY</u>

The Commission finds:

- (1) On June 13, 2014, Jeffrey Gardner (Complainant) filed a complaint against Ohio Power Company dba AEP Ohio (AEP). Complainant alleged that while AEP repaired power lines and replaced a pole near his property, a wire connected to his residence was pulled, nearly detaching the wire holder that connected the power line to his home.
- (2) AEP filed its answer on July 7, 2014, denying Complainant's allegations.
- (3) On July 16, 2014, the attorney examiner issued an entry scheduling a July 30, 2014, settlement conference. The parties met as scheduled and continued settlement discussions afterwards.
- (4) On August 22, 2014, complainant filed a motion to dismiss. Complainant requests that the complaint be dismissed with prejudice, as the parties have reached a settlement.
- (5) The Commission finds that the motion to dismiss the complaint, with prejudice, is reasonable and should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the motion to dismiss the complaint, with prejudice, is granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
