The Commission finds:

- (1) On July 5, 2013, Pete Spooner and Cindy J. Bias (Complainants) filed a complaint against Ohio Edison Company (Ohio Edison) and FirstEnergy Solutions Corp. (FES) (Respondents). The Complainants alleged that Ohio Edison unlawfully switched their electricity service supplier to FES without their consent and failed to provide them with a copy of their bill. The Complainants also contested the accuracy of their bill.
- (2) The Respondents filed a joint answer on August 5, 2013.
- (3) By Entry issued September 10, 2013, the attorney examiner scheduled this matter for a settlement conference. The parties appeared for the settlement conference on October 17, 2014.
- (4) On July 25, 2014, the parties filed a joint motion to dismiss the complaint with prejudice. The parties explain that they have settled this matter and have executed a confidential settlement agreement.
- (5) The parties have stated good cause to dismiss this proceeding. Accordingly, the joint motion to dismiss the complaint with prejudice should be granted.
