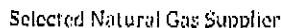

What does "opt-out" mean?

"Opt-out" means that you can decide not to participate in the City of Tallmadge Natural Gas Governmental Aggregation Program. You can opt-out by returning a request form to the City of Tallmadge, or by calling the City of Tallmadge at (440) 325-1000. If you opt-out, you will continue to receive service as a natural gas customer with Constellation Energy, but you will not receive the City of Tallmadge's negotiated natural gas price.

What happens if I do not send in the opt-out form?

If you do not return the opt-out form by the deadline, you will be included in the City of Tallmadge's Natural Gas Governmental Aggregation Program. You will receive the negotiated natural gas price from Constellation Energy.

I am currently under the budget billing option as provided by DEO. Can I retain this service?

There will be no changes in your bill as they relate to budget billing and the method of billing by DEO to calculate the same.

What is Governmental Aggregation and how can I benefit?

Under governmental aggregation, local officials bring the community together to negotiate group purchasing power. The community benefits by receiving competitive rates and natural gas service from a natural gas supplier certified by the Public Utility Commission of Ohio.

How is the City of Tallmadge able to choose a certified natural gas supplier on the community's behalf and who is eligible?

Tallmadge residents voted to give the City of Tallmadge the ability to negotiate on behalf of the community for a contract for a natural gas supplier.

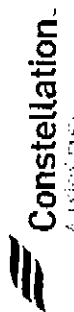
All current participants in the program will receive the new program rates, terms and conditions, and continue to be eligible. Newly eligible residents or businesses must be a residential or commercial customer of Constellation and meet the following requirements:

1. You must either already own an existing gas supplier or your own.
2. You must retain a Pop (Percentage) Income Payment program customer.
3. You must not be in arrears on your bill payment.
4. Your service address must be located within the City of Tallmadge limits.
5. Your utility company must be Dominion East Ohio (DEO).
6. You must not be a participant in customer choice sales or other sales programs as of 09/29/14.

Where can I learn more about natural gas deregulation and assistance programs?

The Public Utilities Commission of Ohio has approved a number of additional assistance programs to help customers with their energy bills. What happens at the end of my Constellation natural gas contract term?

The City of Tallmadge will reset the term and price on behalf of residents. You will then choose a new supplier by the city and a new supplier for the new term.

When will my Constellation natural gas supply begin and how do I know when my meter read occurs?

Supply will start on your first applicable meter reading date. When we estimate to be in December, refer to your bill to get the exact meter read date.

What if I am with another supplier and want to join the City of Tallmadge's program?

Based on the records provided by the utility, we assured you are not a member supplier. Other wise we would have advised you this notice. However, your company is signed up with a new supplier or if you believe you are on an other contract, cancel, request a term's end and record the date of termination before proceeding as your ability to terminate early with that supplier may be restricted.

How can Constellation offer a lower price than DEO's current price?

During select market opportunities, Constellation buys natural gas at a lower price than DEO's. These passes of discounts go to its customers.

How did the City of Tallmadge develop this program?

The City of Tallmadge established a program in accordance with Section 16629.26 of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC), providing the city with the right to natural gas for the provision of Supplier Service to its residential, commercial and small commercial customers. The City is basing out of the program the "Aggregator Program".

What information do I need to opt-out?

Customers will need the following information to opt out of the program: a letter from the utility, a copy of the original opt-out letter, if available, the customer care team can pull up your information based on the service address.

Are there fees associated with the program?

Enrollment in the program is free and you need not pay any action fee. You only need to pay a fee to participate. Once enrolled in the program, you can cancel your agreement at any time and switch back to DEO without any fee.

Will I be allowed to join the program after the initial enrollment period?

The City of Tallmadge has selected the same natural gas supply rate, terms and conditions for eligible customers who wish to join its government aggregation program after the initial enrollment period. The eligible natural gas customers who are in the City of Tallmadge, who are not a member supplier or do not have to join the aggregation program of customers who are not a member and want to join at a later date. These customers will have an individual agreement with Constellation for natural gas supply that will be at the same natural gas supply rate, terms and conditions of the aggregation programs.

What is the rescission period?

The rescission period with DEO is seven days for both residential and commercial customers after enrollment with the natural gas supplier.
