5 The Public Utilities Commission of Ohio calls for
6 hearing at this time and place Case No.
7 14-1217-EL-AEC, being In the Matter of the Dayton
8 Power and Light Company and Wright-Patterson Air
9 Force Base for Approval of a Unique Arrangement.

10 I am Bryce McKenney. I am the

19 MR. MENZA: Good morning, your Honor. My
20 name is Tom Menza. I represent Wright-Patterson Air
21 Force Base and the United States Air Force in this
22 matter.

24 Mr. Menza.

1 MR. McNAMEE: On behalf of the Staff of
2 the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio, Mike DeWine,
3 Attorney General of the State of Ohio, William
4 Wright, Chief, Public Utilities Section, I am Thomas

11 being first duly sworn, as prescribed by law, was
12 examined and testified as follows:

13 DIRECT EXAMINATION

14 By Ms. Sobecki:

15 Q. Thank you, Ms. Segar-Lawson. Please
16 state your employer and the capacity of your
17 employment.

18 A. I am the director of regulatory
19 operations for the Dayton Power and Light Company.

20 Q. Ms. Seger-Lawson, you have two exhibits
21 before you marked Joint Exhibit No. 1 and Joint
22 Exhibit No. 2. Can you please identify those?

23 A. Joint Exhibit No. 1 is the Joint
24 Application of the Dayton Power and Light Company and
25 the Wright-Patterson Air Force Base for Approval of a

1 Unique Arrangement.

2 And Joint Exhibit 2 is my Direct
3 Testimony in support of the unique arrangement.

4 Q. With respect to Joint Exhibit 2, do you
5 have any changes or corrections you would like to
6 make to that today?

7 A. No, I do not.

8 Q. Ms. Seger-Lawson, if I were to ask you
9 the questions listed in your prefiled testimony in
10 this matter here today on the stand, would your
11 answers be the same?

12 A. Yes.

13 Q. And would those answers be truthful?

14 A. Yes.

15 MS. SOBECKI: Your Honor, I have nothing
16 further.

17 THE ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Thank you.

18 Cross-examination on behalf of the base?

19 MR. MENZA: No, your Honor.
