ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) Commission Staff served a notice of preliminary determination upon Central Transport (Respondent), in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-12, alleging a violation of the Commission's transportation regulations.
- (2) On March 31, 2014, Respondent filed a request for an administrative hearing in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-13.
- (3) A prehearing conference was held on May 6, 2014.
- (4) By Entry dated May 6, 2014, this case was scheduled for hearing on June 27, 2014. Subsequently, the case was rescheduled for hearing on August 11, 2014, and October 2, 2014.
- (5) On October 2, 2014, Staff informed the attorney examiner that the parties have reached an agreement in principle and the hearing scheduled for October 2, 2014, is no longer necessary. Accordingly, the attorney examiner finds that the hearing, if needed, should be continued to a date to be established by subsequent entry.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the evidentiary hearing be continued in accordance with finding (5). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
