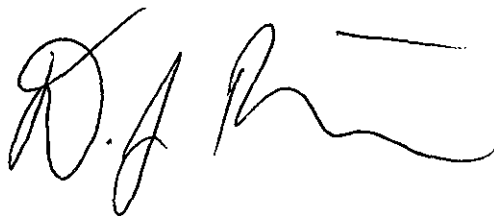
I am NOT in favor of this bailout because it will impact my family's financial bottom like because it will raise rates no matter who we use. Duke should be held accountable for their actions.
