ENTRY ON REHEARING

The Commission finds:


- (1) The Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L) is a public utility as defined under R.C. 4905.02 and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.
- (2) On August 20, 2014, the Commission issued its Opinion and Order (Order) in this case. Pursuant to the Order, the Commission found that Optimizations 2012-A, 2012-B, 2012-C, 2012-D, 2012-H, and 2012-I should be allowed. However, the Commission found that Optimizations 2012-J and 2012-K should be disallowed for not meeting the requirements of proper optimization transactions.
- (3) Pursuant to R.C. 4903.10, any party who has entered an appearance in a Commission proceeding may apply for rehearing with respect to any matters determined by the Commission, within 30 days of the entry of the order upon the Commission's journal.
- (4) On September 19, 2014, the Ohio Consumers' Counsel (OCC) filed an application for rehearing. Subsequently, on September 29, 2014, DP&L filed a memorandum contra the application for rehearing.
- (5) The Commission finds that sufficient reason has been set forth by OCC in its application for rehearing to warrant further consideration of the matters specified in the application for rehearing. Accordingly, the application for rehearing filed by OCC is granted for further consideration of the matters specified in the application for rehearing.

It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That the application for rehearing filed by OCC is granted for further consideration of the matters specified in the application for rehearing. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry on Rehearing be served upon all parties of record.




