The Commission finds:


- (1) On July 11, 2013, American Wire and Cable Company (AWACC) filed a complaint against The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company (CEI) concerning electric service at its Olmsted Township facility, alleging that it experienced high voltage circuit protection interruptions for a period of time ending in mid-January 2013. Thereafter, on July 31, 2013, CEI filed its answer denying the material allegations of the complaint.
- (2) On February 14, 2014, AWACC filed a notice requesting dismissal of its complaint without prejudice.
- (3) This complaint should now be dismissed without prejudice at the request of the complainant, and the record of this case should now be closed.

It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That this complaint be dismissed without prejudice at the request of the complainant, and the record of this case be closed. It is, further,
