ENTRY

The Commission finds:


- (1) Commission Staff served a notice of preliminary determination upon Keith Lewis (Respondent), in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-12, alleging a violation of the Commission's transportation regulations.
- (2) On July 25, 2014, Respondent filed a request for an administrative hearing in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-13.
- (3) A prehearing conference was held on August 26, 2014.
- (4) On October 3, 2014, Staff filed a motion to dismiss this case, in light of the fact that Respondent paid the assessed civil forfeiture in full. Staff notes that, under Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-22, full payment of the civil forfeiture terminates all further proceedings regarding the violation.
- (5) Given Respondent's full payment of the civil forfeiture, the Commission finds that Staff's motion to dismiss should be granted and this case should be closed.

It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That Staff's motion to dismiss be granted and this case be closed.  
It is, further,


ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.


