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MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT

On March 17, 2014, the Ohio Power Siting Board (the "Board") granted Hardin Wind, LLC ("Hardin Wind") a Certificate of Environmental Capability and Public Need to Construct a Wind-Powered Electric Generating Facility in Case Number 13-1177-EL-BGN (the "Certificate"). The Certificate authorized Hardin Wind to construct a wind-powered electric generating facility consisting of 172 wind-powered electric turbines, along with access roads and electric interconnect, construction staging areas, operations and maintenance facilities and a collection substation – all to be located in Hardin and Logan Counties, Ohio and known as the Scioto Ridge Wind Farm.

On September 12, 2014, Hardin Wind filed an Application to Amend the Certificate, Case Number 14-1557-EL-BGA (the "Amendment"). The Amendment proposes adding six new collection lines, shifting six collection lines, relocating 10 access roads, adding two new access roads, relocating one of the four permitted met towers, shifting five turbine locations, and relocating the project collector substation. The Amendment also proposes for consideration two new turbine models.

On October 10, 2014 LHNU filed a Petition to Intervene in this matter. On October 27, 2014, Hardin Wind served by regular mail, its Memorandum Contra LHNU's Petition to Intervene. Accordingly, LHNU's Reply in Support of its Petition to Intervene is due Monday, November 3, 2014.

LHNU respectfully requests a one (1) week extension of time up to and including November 10, 2014 in which to file its Reply. The extension is not opposed by Hardin Wind and will not impact any rulings by the Ohio Power Siting Board or any hearing on this matter. The extension is needed, in part, because Attorney Zachary D. Kravitz, who

was representing LHNU, has left the Firm and has been replaced by new counsel who is reviewing the filings in this matter. Further, this Motion is not filed to cause any undue delay and neither Hardin Wind nor any other Petitioners will be prejudiced by a one (1) week extension for LHNU to file its Reply.

CONCLUSION

For all the foregoing reasons, Petitioner, Logan Hardin Neighbors United respectfully moves the Board to grant it a one (1) week extension of time in which to file its Reply in support of its Petition to Intervene.
