Irpose of the Scarrow 138-XV Transmis sion Line Loop Project is to provide electicity to Markwast's Code Stabilization Plant. ALP Ohio Transco will build the new line using ag-pro-innerely 30 stanktart single-cirruit steel poles. The Sparrow 136 kV transmission line loop will be approximately two miles long. This project will be an approximate \$3 million invastment by AEP Ohio Transco. Construction is scheduled to begin in December 2014
