To Whom It May Concern:

FirstEnergy is playing cat and mouse with it's customers AGAIN (since 2010), by trying to implement their Purchased Power Agreement that would commit local distribution companies to buy ALL the electricity from First Energy generated by the Davis-Besse & WH Sammis Plants **for the next 15 years**. These distribution companies will be obligated to **pay whatever** FirstEnergy says the electricity costs to produce (which will include making upgrades to these two plants). FirstEnergy would then sell this electricity into the wholesale market at either a profit or loss--which will then be **automatically charged to its customers** and appear as a line item on our bills (per FirstEnergy's Rate Plan article in The Plain Dealer).

FirstEnergy has already admitted that for the next 3 years, **this arrangement will knowingly operate at a loss**, and the average customer who uses 750 kwh per month will be charged \$3.50. This charge will be unavoidable regardless of who you get your electricity from because it will be tacked onto the distribution side of the bill. If the average customer's charge at 750kwh is \$3.50 per month, the **average all-electric customer's winter bill usage of 2,600 kwh will experience a bill increase of at least \$11.00 per month**.

If this crappy plan passes, it will essentially allow the regulated and guaranteed profits (**which customers already pay**) from FirstEnergy's distribution companies to subsidize two *unregulated/unprofitable* power plants. **This dealio is totally unfair** to the consumer, and it will completely reverse any progress made since 1999 to de-regulate the generation of electricity in Ohio to form a competitive market. Seems the majority of every organization who has intervened in this rate case plan is opposed to FirstEnergy's ideas due to its negative customer impact and anti-competitive nature, including the Ohio Consumer's Counsel and the PUCO Staff.

Whether it's hurting Ohio citizens financially each month or when they try to sell their all-electric home--will PUCO stop FirstEnergy? PUCO let all-electric consumers down when they let FirstEnergy chip away and phase out the special all-electric rate for its customers. **Will PUCO let us down again** by allowing FirstEnergy to do this underhanded move to its customers?

**In closing we would like to go on record as opposing the First Energy's proposed Purchased Power Agreement to bailout their failing power plants.**



My country home has always been all electric. By my own choice I have taken in and been primary care giver to family members over the years. I charge them nothing to live here, as they buy their own medical necessities and help pay for food.

I currently have my 89 year old WWII veteran father living with me. I have a brother with COPD who is on oxygen always. They are both very temperature sensitive. Dad can keep his coat on, brother has severe breathing trouble when he's too hot or too cold.

Dad goes to daycare during the week so I can work at the cost of \$68 a day. Brother is to the point I will need to retire years early in 2015 to care for him.

I've pulled all electrical stuff I don't need, drive a fuel efficient vehicle, I can control the cost of water usage and food, but I depend on electric to keep them going. We blew in an additional 21 inches of blown insulation in the attic and a new geothermal furnace in 2011. I'm trying, really I am. My 6 year average for electric is approximately 19,000 kWh per year. Raising my electric bill is not really acceptable.

opposed to FirstEnergy's proposed Purchased Power Agreement to bailout their failing power plants.
