I am writing to you today about a serious environmental issue that deeply affects my community and me: air pollution.

I understand that First Energy and Duke have submitted plans to PUCO for financial bailouts of some of their most outdated and expensive coal plants, and thereby forcing customers, such as myself, to buy the power from these old expensive plants for the next 15 years, even though purchasing power from the market has saved customers a lot of money.

I also understand that the Ohio legislature passed a 2-year "freeze" on Ohio's renewable energy standards, which have saved customers \$1.03 billion in just the first 5 years. Although First Energy and Duke say they need time to "study" the issue, the reality is that they just want to kill the program so they can keep the profits. <u>It is imperative that our legislators end the freeze and help customers keep saving money.</u>

Lastly, I understand that the proposed national "Clean Power Plan" was released this past June with the goal of reducing carbon emission from coal-fired power plants. Each state has its own goal to meet by 2030. <u>We need a federal standard so each state complies, which will level the plaving field.</u>

The bottom line is that I care about reducing toxic air pollution and saving money on electric bills, not only for me, but also for my whole community.
