
As an amateur reader about the work of the Ohio PUCO for more than four decades, I want to register my disappointment in one aspect of the agency's work. **I am disappointed at the degree to which the agency subordinates the long-term health and welfare of we who depend on both the energy industry and its regulators to the short-term interests of the producers and distributors of energy.**

Granted, some progress has been made on cleaning air around here; but that may be as much or more due to the decline of heavy industry in northern Ohio than to reduction by coal burners of toxic pollution. The data I see coming out on health matters show a rise in asthma and other respiratory disease among children and adults alike. Toxic elements in the air are one source of that rise. **As a public interest agency, please notice the long-term public value in replacing toxic producing energy with clean energy.** Instead of 12.5 percent of production by renewable sources by 2027, shouldn't the target be the total of the planned increase in production between now and then be from renewable sources.

Since there are going to be many more of us in the future and, therefore, more energy consuming machines to fuel, why are you not taking a longer view of, and preparing now for, the transition to cleaner methods of producing that energy? **Putting more costs on to our energy bills for unfortunate and unsound decisions about past energy production now predictably outdated is wrong.** Investor shareholders bear the benefits and the burdens of their business decisions.

Finally, the large corporations in the energy business are following the unfortunate practice of most corporations dealing with consumers by disaggregating the elements of product, services, fees and other charges in a manner that is too obscure for customers to understand. Indeed, the piles of verbiage given to explain these fragmented elements are themselves an apparent smoke screen rather than a clarification. Since it is entirely irrational in these times to trust corporations to tell the truth in plain terms, it appears that the unpacking of services and charges serves only to obscure the fact that we are being charged by a cabal of profit centers each of which is deemed entitled to reap a profit for its separate contribution to the utility bill. If there is to be a disaggregation of all that goes into our bills, why not make profit on each of the cost items a separate and disclosed item?
