

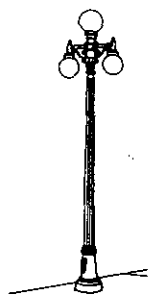

Dear Governor Kasich,

I have seen many of Ohio's largest power plants shut down in just the past few years. This was caused by greater regulations and market challenges. Additional plants are scheduled for closure in the near future. Many Ohio jobs have been lost and will be lost because of this.

For this reason I am asking for your support of First Energy's proposed Electric Security Plan, *Powering Ohio's Progress*. This plan will keep electricity affordable and help ensure the continued operation of Ohio power plants, including the Davis Besse Nuclear Power Plant located in my Village's backyard.

Even though my Village is a Public Power community supplied by AMP, Davis Besse has a huge impact on Oak Harbor. Not only for the people working there living in my community, but the local school district as well. The most recent refueling outage brought millions of dollars to the region.
