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I am writing today to deny the increase of the rates to force us, the consumers, into buying power from Ohio's most inefficient, impractical, and not to mention the most toxic, coal plants. In this day and age, many people require a lot of energy; from heating our homes to powering our lights, but that is indeed something we can live without. Our air, however, is not.

Coal plants are the United States' leading source of SO<sub>2</sub> pollution, which takes a major toll on public health, including by contributing to the formation of small acidic particulates that can penetrate into human lungs and be absorbed by our bloodstreams. A typical coal plant produces 7,000 tons of SO<sub>2</sub> per year. This would cause major health problems in our communities, mainly respiratory related. The particulate matter in the air would cause bronchitis, aggravated asthma, and premature death. NO<sub>x</sub>, the nitrogen oxides emitting from the plants causes ground level ozone, smog, which can burn lung tissue and put people at a higher risk for respiratory diseases. A typical coal plant with emissions controls, including selective catalytic reduction technology, emits 3,300 tons of NO<sub>x</sub> per year. Coal plants are responsible for more than half of the U.S. human-caused emissions of mercury, a toxic heavy metal that causes brain damage and heart problems. Just 1/70th of a teaspoon of mercury deposited on a 25-acre lake can make the fish unsafe to eat. Do you want your children and family breathing in, eating, and drinking these things? Carbon monoxide and arsenic, which can cause cancer and premature death in people of all ages, are also leaked from the plants.

China, as you know, is suffering from the air pollution caused by factories and power plants. Some even dare to call them the "Face-Mask Nation". I do not think that you want that for our country, correct? I have asked my brother, who is a student in kindergarten, (age 5) and my sister (age 4) to draw what they want the Earth to look like when they grow up. If you go through with this plan, will these pictures ever be a reality? Will your grandchildren grow up in a polluted world or not? The answers are all dependent on what you decide now.
