To the PUCO:

We are writing in strong opposition to First Energy's proposed Purchased Power Agreement (PPA) to bailout their failing power plants.

The PPA would intentionally harm all Ohioans, but in particular would significantly increase the monthly costs to all-electric homes. This "Plan" simply forces the public to subsidize two unregulated and unprofitable power plants (Davis Besse and WH Sammis). First Energy is morally obligated to use corporate profits to pay to keep these plans running under regulation – not the consumers.

As all-electric customers we are continually forced to fight for our contractual rights with First Energy. They have a long history of not honoring contracts, and this is simply one more example of their corporate overstep.

Dear Sirs:

I want to go on record that I oppose FirstEnergy's proposed Purchased Power Agreement to bailout their failing power plants, the Davis-Besse and W. H. Sammis Plants.

I own a single family residence in an all-electric development. At the time this house was built, the developer was offered financial incentives by the electric company to build all-electric homes. Gas lines were not installed in this development.

From November 2013-November 2014, I used 41,774 kwh (3,481.17 kwh on a monthly basis) to operate my home. Under FirstEnergy's proposed plan, I would pay an additional \$16.25 monthly or \$194.94552 (almost \$195.00 additional) to operate my home.

My husband and I are retired and on a fixed income. We have to pay to maintain the safety and upkeep on our home. FirstEnergy should have to pay to maintain the safety, energy efficiency, and upkeep on their power plants. This cost should not be passed onto to us the consumer.

Again, I am **opposed to FirstEnergy's proposed Purchased Power Agreement to bailout their failing power plants.**
