ENTRY ON REHEARING

The Commission finds:

- (1) R.C. 106.03 requires all state agencies to conduct a review, every five years, of their rules and to determine whether to continue their rules without change, amend their rules, or rescind their rules. The rules in Ohio Adm.Code Chapter 4901:1-25 govern market monitoring.
- (2) On October 15, 2014, the Commission issued its Finding and Order, adopting the rules in Ohio Adm.Code Chapter 4901:1-25. Pursuant to R.C. 4903.10, any party who has entered an appearance in a Commission proceeding may apply for rehearing with respect to any matters determined by the Commission, within 30 days of the entry of the Order upon the Commission's journal.
- (3) On November 14, 2014, the Ohio Consumers' Counsel (OCC) filed an application for rehearing. Thereafter, memoranda contra to OCC's application for rehearing were filed by Direct Energy Services, LLC (Direct Energy), Retail Energy Supply Association (RESA), the Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company, the Toledo Edison Company, and Ohio Edison Company (collectively, FirstEnergy), and FirstEnergy Solutions Corporation (FES).
- (4) The Commission finds that sufficient reason has been set forth in the application for rehearing filed by OCC and the memoranda contra to warrant further consideration of the matters specified in the application for rehearing. Accordingly, the application for rehearing filed by OCC should be granted for further consideration of the matters specified in the application for rehearing.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the application for rehearing filed by OCC be granted for further consideration of the matters specified in the application for rehearing. It is, further,
