
MOTION TO DISMISS COMPLAINT

On October 29, 2014, pursuant to the October 27, 2014, Entry and Order of Attorney Examiner Daniel Fullin, Complainant and Respondent attended a settlement conference with the purpose of potentially reaching a resolution to the Complaint. The settlement conference reconvened by teleconference on October 31 and the Parties were able to reach an agreement resolving all issues and Complainant now asks the Commission to dismiss the Complaint. In requesting this dismissal, Complainant states that although she does not admit the affirmative defenses in Respondent's Answer, Complainant does agree that this settlement is an acceptable compromise and conclusion of all issues in this case.

WHEREFORE, Complainant Stacy Longstreath hereby respectfully asks the Commission to dismiss the Complaint with prejudice, as the matter has been settled.


