ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) Pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-2, Commission Staff served a notice of preliminary determination upon FMT Trucking, LLC (FMT) alleging violations of the Commission's transportation regulations.
- (2) On September 25, 2014, FMT filed a request for an administrative hearing in the above-captioned case in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-13.
- (3) A prehearing settlement conference was held on October 30, 2014; however, the parties were unable to settle this matter.
- (4) Accordingly, this matter shall be set for hearing on January 29, 2015, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, 11th Floor, Hearing Room 11-D, Columbus, Ohio 43215-3793.
- (5) At the hearing, Staff must prove, by a preponderance of the evidence, the occurrence of a violation, pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-20(A).

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That a hearing in this case be scheduled for January 29, 2015, in accordance with Finding (4). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon each party of record.
