



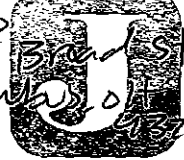

It has come to my attention that FirstEnergy Corporation, from which the City of Hudson purchases electricity, has requested that the cost of energy and the source of energy purchased be frozen for a long period—fifteen years, I think. I sincerely hope the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio will reject this request.

FirstEnergy currently runs a notoriously outdated, inefficient and dirty operation. Certainly in this age of environmental challenges it is reasonable to expect that they will have to invest in their infrastructure to meet public standards of efficiency and to develop much needed sources of renewable energy. It is not reasonable to expect the company to be bailed out on the backs of its users. To disallow competition and to set up a situation whereby rates can be increased with no recourse is simply unethical. It profits stockholders by punishing customers.


First, citizens of Ohio are painfully aware of the age of our coal plants and subsequently their inefficiency and exceptionally high rate of emission of pollutants. Anyone aware of the critical crisis we face regarding quality of air and the impact of old coal burning plants on the environment and on climate change must realize that this situation must be addressed without delay by the providers themselves.

Second, in order to remedy some of the problems with the aging plants it is my understanding that FirstEnergy is requesting that current customers be locked into buying power from them, making it impossible to shop for suppliers who are more economic for the users and less damaging to the environment as a whole.

Finally, and particularly as a retiree living on a fixed income, it is my strong, and I think reasonable, opinion that the cost of making the changes that FirstEnergy must make to stay competitive should be born by shareholders rather than users, particularly users who might be denied the opportunity to shop for electricity elsewhere.
