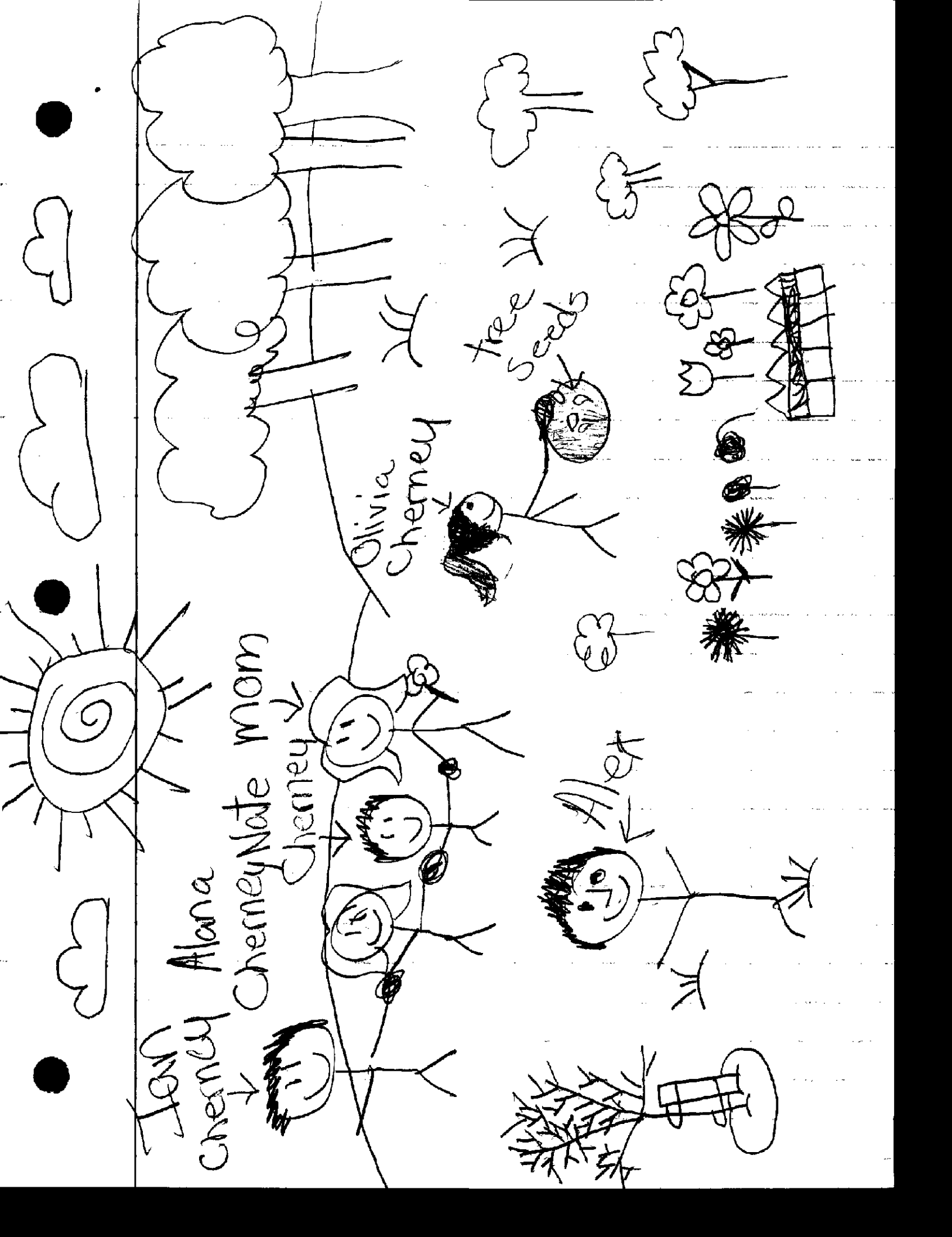

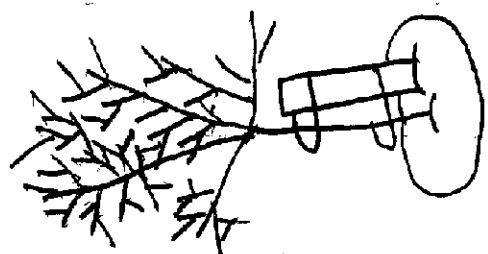

To Whom It May Concern:

I am writing to ask that you deny the rate increase to lock customers into buying power from Ohio's oldest, and dirtiest coal plants. I am environmentally conscious and drive a hybrid to help protect the environment. I heat or cool only the rooms in which we are actively living as well as keeping blinds and curtains drawn to reduce energy use.

I am a customer of Duke Energy and since they purchased Cincinnati Gas & Electric Company we have seen our energy bills escalate constantly and dramatically! I have had to turn the thermostat down (during the winter period) or up (during the summer period) and we all wear more or less clothing in order to be comfortable.

Duke Energy installed new meters that now monitor what time of day we use energy and it appears that we are being charged at a higher rate during peak times – i.e., at times when most people return from work each day when we cannot avoid using more energy.

I understand that all companies must make a profit, but bailing out a utility only benefits the shareholders and simply delays the inevitable investment in replacing the old plant. Duke Energy will again pass along to us the cost for replacement as well as the bailout. **Duke Energy knew about the status of these coal plants when they purchased Cincinnati Gas and Electric and should have internally planned for the associated replacement costs – costs that should not be off-loaded to the public.**

I am 66 years old and like many people, I have had to delay my retirement for the reason that my utilities and monthly expenses continue to increase while I know that my retirement won't keep pace.

Ohio residents need help to recover from this economic downturn and paying higher utilities will only put us further behind and delay our recovery. And our economy is built on the middle class which has taken the biggest hit during this downturn.
