

American Transmission Systems, incorporated (ATSI), a FirstEnergy company, propos to construct the Eastiake-Lloyd (Q-12 & Q-13) 138-Rivordt (kV) Transmission Line Structure Addition Project (Project), in a Letter of Notification Application submitted to the Orio Power Siting Board (Board) for a Centricate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need

A Letter of Notification Application for a certificate to construct operato, and maintain the above named electric transmission line facility is now pending before the Board. The 1 Eastano-Lloyd (0-12 & 0-13) 133 kV Transmission Line Structure Addition. Project application has been assigned Docket No. 14/2129-EL-BLN, and the docket number pricessors and trucks are dissipations as in bearingers et bruche

In accordance with the Orio Power String Board regulations (Admin. Code Rule 4905-5-(3), the following sections of the Orio Revised Code plus additional information are show Section 4906.10(A)

(A) The Power Sting Board shall render a decision upon the record either granting or denying the Application as Bed, or granking it upon such terms, conditions, or modifications of the construction, operation, or maintenance of the major utility facility as the Board considers appropriate. The certificate shall be conditioned upon the facility being in compliance with standards and rules adopted under sections 1501.33, 1501.34, and 4581.32 and Chapters 3704, 3734, and 6111 of the Revised Code. The period of radal operation under a cartificate shall expire two years after the date on which electric power is first generated by the facility. During the period of initial operation, the lacility shall be subject to the enforcement and monitoring powers of the director of envronmental protection under Chapters 3704, 3734, and 6111 of the Revised Code and to the emergency provisions under those chapters. If a major utility facility constructed in accordance with the terms and conditions of its certificate is unable to operate in compliance with all applicable requirements of state laws, rules, and standards pertain to air pollution, the facility may epply to the director of environmental protection for a conditional operating permit under division (G) of section 3704.03 of the Revised Code and the rules adopted thereunder. The operation of a major using facility in compliance with a conditional operating permit is not in violation of its contribute. After the expiration of the period of initial operation of a major utility facility, the facility shall be under the jurishiftion of the Emfronmental Protection Agency and shall comply with all laws, rules, and standards pertaining to air postulion, water postulion, and solid and hazardous waste disposal. The Board shall not grant a cortificate for the construction, operation, and maintenance of

a major utility tacity, either as proposed or as modified by the Bhard, turiess it finds and determines all of the following:

- (1) The basis of the need for the leading if the leading is an electric transmission line or gas or natural gos bansmission line;
- (2) The nature of the probable environmental impact:
- (3) That the lacity represents the minimum edverse environmental impact, considering the state of available technology and the nature and economics of the various alternatives, and offer perinera considerations.
- (4) in the case of an electric transmission line or generating leasity, that the lacity is consistent with regional plans for expansion of the electric power grid of the electric systems sorving this state and interconnected utility systems and that the facility will serve a interests of electric system economy and refelicity;
- (5) That the facility will comply with Chapters 3704, 3724, and 6111 of the Revised Code and all rules and standards adopted under those chargers and under sections 1501.33, 1501.34, and 4561.32 of the Revised Code. In determining whether the largery well comply with all rules and standards adopted under section 4501.32 of the Reviseo Code, the Board shad consult with the Office of Aviation of the Division of Multi-Modal Planning and Programs of the Department of Transportation under section 4561-341 of the Revised Code.
