ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On September 21, 2014, Stacy Longstreath (Complainant) filed a complaint against The Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L). Complainant contends that she moved from Blueberry Avenue in Dayton, paid her DP&L bill in full, and asked for transfer of service to Miller Avenue in Dayton. However, her Percentage of Income Payment Plan (PIPP) was not transferred to Miller Avenue, and DP&L turned off power at that location. Complainant asserts that she contacted DP&L about the disconnection and paid \$706 as DP&L directed. Complainant emphasizes that she "doesn't have a PIPP default" and states that she owes only \$278.47 for service at Idlewild Boulevard in Dayton.
- (2) DP&L filed its answer on October 15, 2014. DP&L states that service to Complainant was disconnected for nonpayment at Blueberry Avenue and Miller Avenue. DP&L further contends that that Complainant had illegally reconnected service at Blueberry Avenue, Miller Avenue, and Idlewild Boulevard. DP&L disagrees with Complainant concerning the amount that is owed to DP&L.
- (3) On October 27, 2014, the attorney examiner issued an entry scheduling an October 29, 2014, settlement conference. The parties met as scheduled and continued settlement discussions in an October 31, 2014, teleconference.

- (4) On December 18, 2014, Complainant filed a motion to dismiss. Complainant requests that the complaint be dismissed with prejudice, as the parties have reached a settlement.
- (5) The Commission finds that the motion to dismiss the complaint, with prejudice, is reasonable and should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the motion to dismiss the complaint, with prejudice, is granted.  
It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
