Question: The Ohio Commission rules prohibit the double-counting of renewable resources. Is the Boone National Guard solar facility intended to satisfy any other state or federal renewable requirements, or will the facility's output be relied upon to satisfy any renewable/solar claims absent the accompanying S-RECs?

Answer: The intent of the 40.2 kW roof mounted solar array is not to satisfy any state or federal requirements but to offset the building's energy consumption. The Kentucky Army National Guard is working towards the goals detailed in Executive Order (EO) 13514, "Federal Leadership in Environmental, Energy, and Economic Performance", Executive Order (EO) 13423, "Strengthening Federal Environmental, Energy, and Transportation Management" and 10 U.S.C. § 2911, Energy Performance Goals and Plan for Department of Defense.
