## The Commission finds:

- (1) On March 5, 2014, Bizcorp, LLC (Bizcorp or Complainant) filed a complaint against Windstream Communications, Inc. (Windstream or Respondent). Bizcorp alleged that it had experienced telecommunication service interruptions, missing fax lines, inaccurate billings, back billings, and failures to respond adequately to service inquiries.
- (2) On March 26, 2014, Windstream filed an answer and a motion to dismiss the complaint.
- (3) By Entry issued April 23, 2014, the attorney examiner scheduled this matter for a settlement conference.
- (4) On January 9, 2015, the parties filed a joint motion to dismiss the complaint with prejudice. The parties explain in the motion that all issues have been settled.
- (5) The Commission finds that the motion to dismiss the complaint with prejudice is for good cause and should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the joint motion to dismiss be granted and the complaint be dismissed with prejudice. It is, further,

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ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties and interested persons of record.
