The Ohio Rail Development Commission (ORDC) has authorized funding for Norfolk Southern Railway (NS) to upgrade the mast-mounted flashing lights and roadway gates at the following locations:

Scioto County, near Wheelersburg, Hayport Rd/CR 257, DOT# 473458G, upgrade to LED inserts on gate arms, 12" LED's on mast-mounted flashing lights, constant warning time crossing circuitry, approved cost \$179,843.25.

Scioto County, Porter Township, Center St/TR 256, DOT# 473459N, upgrade to LED inserts on gate arms, 12" LED's on mast-mounted flashing lights, constant warning time crossing circuitry, approved cost \$159,468.00.

These crossings were recommended for upgrade as part of the Heartland Corridor Project.

The projects will be paid for with federal funds, and are actual cost. As the plans and estimates in the above referenced amounts have already been approved, staff requests a Finding & Order with completion in nine months. Construction may commence at once. Staff requests that the following language be incorporated in the Entry:

It is expected that all work necessary for FHWA acceptance of the warning devices will be completed by the in-service due date and that the railroad will be responsible for this work. This work includes, but is not limited to:

Any ancillary work to make the warning devices function as designed and visible to the roadway user, and

MUTCD compliance, including minor roadway work if necessary.

A suggested case coding and heading would be:

Norfolk Southern (NS) may proceed with the construction of the proposed grade crossing warning system in accordance with the abbreviated plan. This authorization is made with the stipulation and understanding that the approved estimate may contain entries for items or activities that may be cited and found to be ineligible for federal participation during the project audit. Reimbursement of eligible actual cost is limited to \$179,843.25. Additional costs must be approved in writing by the Ohio Rail Development Commission (ORDC) prior to being incurred.
