NOTICE OF PROPOSED MAJOR UTILITY FACILITY

AEP Ohio, a unit of American Electric Power (AEP), and the AEP Ohlo Transmission Company, propose to construct a new 138-kilovolt (kV) electric transmission substation in Jefferson County.

The project is known as the Gable Substation Project. As required by Ohio Revised Code Section 4906, AEP Ohio seeks a Certificate of Environmen-tal compatibility and Public Need from the state of Ohio Power Shino Board.

DATE, TIME AND LOCATIONS OF PUBLIC HEARING

The public hearing in this case shall consist of two parts

(a) a local public hearing, pursuant to Section 4906-08(C), Revised Code, where the Power Siting Board shall accept written or oral testimony from any person. This non-adjudicatory hearing will begin at 6 p.m., Tuesday, April 7, 2015, at the Wells Township Community Center, 107 Steuben Street, Britllant, Dhio 43913, and

(b) an adjudicatory hearing commencing at 10 a.m. Thursday, April 23, 2015, 11th Floor. Hearing Room 11-D, at the offices of the Public Utilities Commission of Ohlo, 180 East Broad Street. Columbus, Ohio, 43215-3793. The hearing on April 23, 2015, at the PUCO offices is open to the public, but participation is limited to the parties in the case as defined by ORC 4906.08

This notice is the first notice published regarding this project's respective hearing dates. A second notice will be published in the same newspaper in Anril 2015

The application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is pending before the state of Ohio Power Siting Board. This application has been assigned Case Number 14-1280-EL-BSB. This number should be included in all communications with respect to this project.

Petitions to Intervene in the adjudicatory hearing will be accepted by the board up to 30 days following publication of this notice required by Rule 4306-5-08(C)(1). 0 A C, or by March 9, 2015, whichever is later. However, the board strongly encourages interested persons who wish to intervene in the adjudicatory hearing to file their petitions as early as possible. Petitions should be addressed to Public Utilities Commission of Ohio 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio, 43215-3793 and cite Case Number 14, 1280 EL BSB

The company plans to construct the new estimated 1 6-acre Gable Substation about 10 miles southwest of Steubenville, Ohio in the Wells Township of Jefferson County. The proposed substation will Hkely be constructed near the intersection of County Road 17 and County Road 15, depending on the site selected

Gable Substation will allow AFP Obio to increase the reliability of the electric transmission grid. The new substation will reduce the likelihood of outages and speed restoration by dividing the existing transmission lines into smaller sections. AEP can also better direct the flow of electric power with the installation of the Gable Substation.

AEP projects Gable Substation, an approximate \$2 million investment, will contribute approximately \$67,000 in property taxes to the community.

The accompanying map depicts the two proposed sites for the Gable Substation. It should be noted that due to the reduced scale and limited detail, this map should be used only as a general guide Copies of the actual sitting application, including specific details about the location and construction are available for public inspection at the following location



CRITERIA USED TO REVIEW THE APPLICATION

The following eight criteria are set forth in Section 4906.10 (A) of the Revised Code and will be used. along with additional information, by the board in reviewing the application for a certificate to construct, operate and maintain the Gable Substation:

- · The basis of need for the facility
- · The nature of the probable environmental impact of the proposed facility:
- . The facility represents the minimum adverse environmental impact, considering the state of available technology, the nature and economics of alternatives and other pertinent consider-
- In the case of electric transmission lines, that the facility is consistent with regional plans for expansion of the electric power grid of the electric systems serving Ohio and interconnected systems, and that the facility will serve the interests of electric system economy and reliability
- The facility will comply with chapters 3704 3734 and 6111 of the Revised Code and all rules and standards adopted under sections 1501.33, 1501 34 and 4561.32 of the Revised Code. In determining whether the facility will comply with all rules and standards adopted under Section 4561 34 of the Revised Code, the board shall consult with the office of aviation of the division of multi-modal planning and programs of the

Department of Transportation under Section 4361 341 of the Revised Code

 The facility will serve the public Interest. convenience and necessity

- · The facility's impact on the viability as agricultural land of any land in an existing agricultural district established under Chapter 929 of the Revised Code that Is located within the site of the proposed major utility facility; and
- . The facility incorporates maximum feasible water conservation practices as determined by the board considering available technology and the nature and economics of various alternatives

Section 4906.07, Revised Code provides that

Upon the receipt of an application, complying with Section 4906 06 of the Revised Code, the power siting board shall promptly fix a date for a public hearing thereon not less than 60 or more than 90 days after such receipt and shall conclude the proceeding as expeditiously as practicable

On the application for an amendment of a certificate, the board shall hold a hearing in the same manner as a hearing is held for an application for a certificate if the proposed change in the facility would result in any material increase in any environmental impact of the facility or a substantial change in the location of all or a portion of such facility other than as provided in the alternates set forth in the application.

The chairman of the power siting board shall cause each application filed with the board to be investigated and shall not less than 15 days prior to the date any application is set for hearing. submit a written report to the board and to the applicant. A copy of such report shall be made available to any person upon request. Such report shall set forth the nature of the investigation and shall contain recommended findings with regard to division (A) of Section 4906.10 of the Revised Code and shall become part of the record and served upon all parties to the proceeding.
