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## **MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT OF TITAN ENERGY - NEW ENGLAND'S** MOTION FOR EXTENTION

Contemporaneously with this Motion for Extension, Titan Energy - New England, Inc. ("Titan"), filed its Renewal Application for Certification as a Competitive Retail Electric Service Provider ("Renewal Application") in Case No. 13-0535-EL-AGG. Unfortunately, through inadvertence, Titan did not file its Renewal Application at least 30 days prior to the expiration of Certificate No. 13-665E(1), as required by Ohio Administrative Code Rule 4901:1-24-09(A). Titan regrets the delay in filing its Renewal Application and assures the Commission that it will use every effort to file future renewal applications in a timely manner.

Ohio Administrative Code Rule 4901:1-24-09(B) provides that a motion requesting an extension of a certificate will be deemed automatically approved (unless the Commission or an attorney examiner rules otherwise within three days of the motion's filing), if a renewal application is filed fewer than thirty calendar days prior to the certificate's expiration date, but no later than the expiration date. Titan's Renewal Application and this contemporaneous Motion for Extension have been filed within the applicable time frames provided by Ohio Administrative Code Rule 4901:1-24-09(B).

Therefore, Titan respectfully moves the Commission to automatically extend the expiration date of Certificate No. 13-665E(1), which is due to expire on March 29, 2015, for a period of 31 days after the filing of Titan's Renewal Application or until the date that the new certificate is issued.
