MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF CERTIFICATE

All Things Energy submits that it has met the criteria and respectfully requests an automatic extension of the expiration date of Certificate No. 13-654E(1) issued in Case No. 13-406-EL-CRS to March 19, 2015 or until such time as a new renewal certificate is issued so as not to interrupt service to customers.
