installation in the Flint Ridge Development (between mile 13 and 14). Keeping track of the proceedings on your website, we once again want to express the negative impact this pipeline would have in our neighborhood. The safety concerns of a pipeline so close to homes is disturbing. The pipeline will cross under Ohio Edison's electrical power transmission lines and the LORCO sewer line three times as it is routed through the neighborhood. This is a potential catastrophe waiting to happen. Our development has only one entrance and exit, the pipeline would pass under this road. If an unforseen issue were to develop residents would be trapped with no hope of safety forces having access to the home owners. We have previously submitted petitions signed by the residents of Flint Ridge in opposition of the NRG pipeline through our development. State Representative Matt Lundy has also expressed in writing his concerns for the proposed route through Flint Ridge. Talking with workers on our property from Ohio Edison and Hanover Engineering and Construction (the company to be used to install the pipeline), they were surprised and concerned with the pipelines route and thought that it would be better if moved to the available empty neighboring fields to the east of Flint Ridge.

We are once again requesting that you deny approval of NRG's proposed routing of the pipeline through the Flint Ridge Development due to safety concerns, massive destruction and devaluation of property value this would cause. Thank you. Gary and Kathleen Conlin
