## **ENTRY**

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On February 23, 2015, an Entry was issued in this matter scheduling an April 16, 2015 hearing date.
- (2) Staff filed a motion on March 9, 2015, to reschedule the hearing date. Staff explains that the inspector who prepared the inspection report cannot appear for a hearing on April 16, 2015. Staff adds that no party to this case opposes rescheduling of the hearing to April 15, 2015, at 9:00 a.m.
- (3) Accordingly, the hearing shall be rescheduled for April 15, 2015, at 9:00 a.m. in Hearing Room 11-B, at the Commission offices, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215-3793.
- (4) Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-14(E), provides that a respondent who has requested an administrative hearing and fails to participate in the hearing proceeding shall be in default. The rule additionally states that a respondent in default shall be deemed to have admitted the occurrence of the violation and waived all further right to contest liability to the state for the forfeiture described in the notice.
- (5) At the hearing, staff must prove, by a preponderance of the evidence, that respondent committed the alleged violation, pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-20(A).

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the hearing be rescheduled as indicated in Finding (3). It is, further,
