ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) R.C. 4928.64(D)(1) requires the Commission to submit an annual report to the General Assembly describing the compliance of electric distribution utilities and electric services companies with R.C. 4928.64(B). Pursuant to R.C. 4928.64(D)(2), the annual report must describe the average annual cost of renewable energy credits purchased by utilities and companies for the year covered in the report.
- (2) By Entry issued on February 26, 2015, attorney examiner ordered that each electric distribution utility and electric services company with a 2013 compliance requirement file in this docket by March 12, 2015, the average cost data for the renewable energy credits (RECs) that it retired.
- (3) Thereafter, on March 11, 2015, Border Energy Electric Services, Inc. (Border) filed a motion and memorandum in support to continue the deadline for it to file its report, as well as a request for expedited treatment pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901-1-12(C). Border requests an extension of 30 days from the March 12, 2015, filing deadline to file its report. Border asserts that good cause exists for the granting of its motion because in the fourth quarter of 2014, Border was acquired by Interstate Gas Supply, Inc. (IGS). As a result of the acquisition, Border and IGS have engaged in a process to transition Border's historical REC information to a new database. Due to this transition process, Border has been unable to calculate the historical average REC acquisition costs before the March 12, 2015 deadline.
- (4) The attorney examiner finds that Border's motion is reasonable and should be granted. Accordingly, Border should file its historical average REC acquisition costs in this docket not later than April 10, 2015.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That Border's motion for an extension of time to file its report is granted, in accordance with Finding (4). It is, further,

ORDERED, That notice or a copy of this Entry be served upon each party of record.
